Other Reports

1. Second Semester Examination/Closing: The examination was conducted between Monday July 3 and Friday July 21, 2023. Closing Assembly was also held on Friday July 21, 2023 and students were thereafter released to go home.



2. Discipline: We wish to report that most of our students conducted themselves very well in the course of the semester. We however also had a few cases of students who did not behave properly and had to face disciplinary actions. We enjoin parents and guardians to constantly counsel their wards.



3. No Loss: We are grateful to God for the health and well-being of our students in the out gone session. No loss was recorded and none shall ever be recorded in Jesus name.

4. Graduating Students: We congratulate our second set of graduating students who have also finished their exams, and are only going to stay back a while to complete their projects. We congratulate all their parents and guardians, as well, on this feat, as we further commend them to the hands of God, as they are set to impact the world.

5. School Fees: All students are required to pay their school fees at once. For those who are unable to pay at once, however, there is room to spread payment over a maximum of four installments, in strict compliance of the schedule below.

- **40% before resumption of first semester.**
- **20% before the first semester examinations.**
- **20% before the resumption of second semester.**
- **20% before the second semester examinations.**

Parents are to kindly note that students are required to have made a minimum of 80% payment of their respective fees before resumption for the second semester.

Any student who is still owing for this last semester shall not be allowed to resume in the new session. All students have been directed to obtain their payment schedules from the Accounts Unit.

6. Summer Classes: The Summer School shall open on Monday August 7, 2023, while the hostels would be open to the boarding students from Sunday August 6, 2023. All students concerned with the Summer School are to ensure that they register their courses before leaving for this vacation, or do it online before commencement of the school.

7. SIWES: We wish to appeal to parents to please assist their wards in securing work places for all categories of students due for the mandatory Students Industrial Work Experience Scheme (SIWES), that is, those who would not be taking part in the Summer School.

8. New Session Resumption: The resumption date for the 2023/24 academic session shall be communicated to all parents and students in the course of time. Please be on the look out.
